School Annual Report

It is with great pride and immense pleasure that I present to you the Annual Report for this academic year 2024 - 2025. As we reflect on the progress we have made and the challenges we have overcome, we celebrate the collective efforts of our Management, our students, teachers, parents, and the entire school community in shaping a year of growth and achievement.

Let us begin with our commendable performances in the CBSE Board Examinations. We had our tenth and twelfth batch of students who appeared for Class XII and Class X CBSE Board Examination in March 2024, respectively. I am glad to inform this august gathering that the Academic Year 2023 - 24, our students have once again demonstrated exceptional academic achievements in the CBSE board exams and as always, we achieved 100% result. In Class X, Chiragvir Sigh Tandon scored an aggregate of 99%. Around 93 students scored 90% and above. In Class XII Minerva Digra of Humanities scored 97%, Amulya Mahajan of Commerce scored 95.2%, Nivriti Sharma from Bio Science (Medical) scored 93.8% whereas Ridhima Sharma of Math Science (Non-Medical) scored 90.2%. Around 21 students have scored 90% and above in aggregate. On behalf of our Management, I would like to congratulate all the students, their parents, and the teachers whose toil and determination have paid off.

We at G D Goenka Public School, Jammu have been proactive in embracing the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020, ensuring that our educational practices align with its vision of holistic, inclusive, and learner-centered education. Adhering to the new structure of 5+3+3+4 of school education, we have incorporated Montessori method of learning in the Foundational Stage since last academic year. The day commenced with an educational assembly that included lively dance performances and catchy songs. This was followed by a visit to the silk factory which was quite enriching. The day continued with a movie screening with students savouring delicious popcorn, followed by some creative vegetable printing activities. To top it all, the children were mesmerised by an amazing puppet show that sparked their imagination. It was a day full of laughter, learning and new experiences; proving that learning can be exciting and enjoyable beyond the classroom.

Animals constitute an intrinsic part of human existence. The responsibility of their protection and conservation lies on our shoulders. With this noble thought in mind, the quintessential event of Fauna Fiesta was celebrated by our students of Class 3 on the 27th of April 2024. Stepping into the colourful world of our third-grade students, one could embark on a captivating journey through the extraordinary animal kingdom! With boundless enthusiasm and a thirst for learning, our young explorers had transformed their classrooms into bustling hubs of wildlife wonder.
